Monday

\$600 High Hands every 30 minutes with
ROLLOVERS 12p to 9p

Sunday

Opening \$50 Full House 8's or better 9a to 12p (10 max)
\$400 High Hands every 30 minutes 12p to 8p
\$100 Full House 8's or better 10p to 1a (10 max)

\$700 High Hands every 30 minutes with Rollovers 12p to 9p

Dania Poker Room May Promotions

Rules

1. Full House promotions must be 8's full or better using both whole cards and will be combined with the high hands. Tournaments don't qualify.
2. High hand must be a minimum of Aces Full to qualify (unless otherwise stated)
3. Two cards get 100% of the posted prize, and one card receives 50% of the posted prize
4. There must be at least \$10 in the pot (including rake and jackpot) to win high hand.
5. In the event of a high-hand tie, the posted prize will be split. If one hand is a 2-card and the other is a 1-card, the 2-card hand will receive 50% of the prize, and the 1-card hand will receive 25% (half of the 50%).
6. Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday rollovers will be in effect from 9 am to 12 pm. When the noon promotion ends, the high hands will be \$200 every 30 minutes until midnight without Rollovers.
7. On promotional \$1000 High Hand days, there will be no rollovers or full houses when the promotion ends.
8. On the announcement of the completion of the period or the clock sounding, the period is over, and any new high hands will apply to the next period.
9. If there is no winner at the end of the promotion period. The amount will remain posted for the next time period until that prize has been won.
10. All Omaha games qualify for High Hand promotions 100%. The hand must be flopped to be considered a High Hand.
11. Hands must be verified by poker room staff and winners must be present.
12. Players must play in a Jackpot-eligible Texas Hold'em, Stud, or Omaha game.
13. Jackpot-eligible games are defined as any game where a jackpot drop is being taken and includes tournaments that have jackpot money taken.
14. Anyone found to violate the integrity of this promotion shall be disqualified. This includes soft playing, slow rolling, or slow playing.

Non-promotional times between 9 am – 12 pm
\$200 High Hands every 30 minutes with Rollovers

Tournaments qualify for high hands. Tournaments ONLY receive 50% of the posted prize with two cards, and 25% of the posted prize with one card.

Midnight to Close
\$100 High Hands every 60 minutes

Full House Bonus will run alongside the High Hands
Two cards get 100% of the posted prize, and one card receives 50% of the posted prize.
